The Principles of Public Worship (Part 1)

...A service of public worship is not merely a gathering of God's children with each other but before all else a meeting of the triune God with his chosen people... The Lord Jesus Christ said: "Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them." The end of public worship is the glory of God. Public worship is Christian when the worshipers recognize that Christ is the Mediator by whom alone they can come unto God... and when their worship is an expression of their faith in Christ and of their love for him.

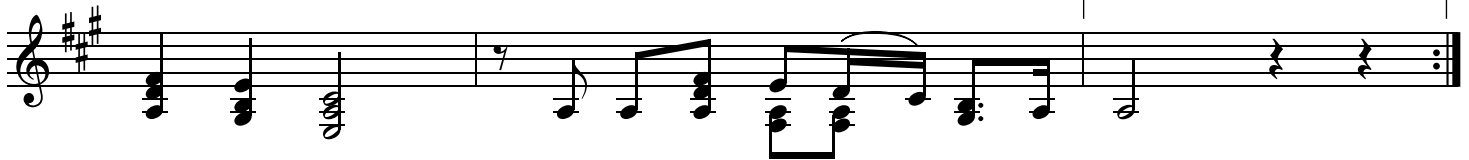




